PLEASE REMEMBER

- Propane and white gas BBQs and stoves are allowed in the Spillway Parking lot.
- Fire danger is extremely high due to the drought conditions. ALL fireworks are illegal outside of Oroville City limits.
- No fireworks, including 'Safe & Sane' are allowed in any area of the Oroville Dam, campgrounds, parking lots, boat ramps or surrounding areas in the County of Butte. The only fireworks allowed will be the authorized display over Lake Oroville.
- No private drones in fireworks area.
- No BBQ, grilling, cooking or open flame of any kind are allowed in any of the parking areas. These activities are allowed only in designated day use or campsite areas.
- You may want to bring a flashlight for returning to your vehicle after the event, portable chairs and a light jacket since it can get breezy near the water after dark.
- No glass containers are allowed.







PLEASE Remember These Regulations:

1. Propane and white gas BBQs and stoves are allowed in the Spillway Parking lot.
2. Any fireworks, including 'Safe & Sane', are illegal outside the limits of the City of Oroville.
3. No unauthorized fireworks displays are allowed in any area of the Oroville Dam, campgrounds, parking lots, or boat ramps or surrounding areas in the County of Butte. This includes 'Safe & Sane' fireworks. The only fireworks allowed will be the display over Lake Oroville.
4. No BBQ, grilling, cooking or open flame of any kind are allowed in any of the parking areas. These activities are allowed only in designated day use or campsite areas.
5. Vessel navigational lights are required at sunset and the vessel speed limit is 5 MPH 30 minutes after sunset.
6. Please be extra careful wherever you are this summer due to the extreme drought conditions.
7. Traffic on top of Oroville Dam will become one way (going in) at 3:00pm on July 4th, or as soon as the Spillway parking lot is full. Oroville Dam will close to all vehicular traffic at 5:00pm. After that time you may leave by the abutment road on the west side of the dam, but you may not return by vehicle.
8. The Upper Overlook Parking Lot will be open, as well as the nearby Visitor Center parking lot. ADA parking, with placard or permanent license plate only, is at the south end of the dam, near the permanent restroom facilities.
9. If you park in the neighborhood please DO NOT leave your trash. Please take it with you and help keep the area clean.
10. It is recommended that you bring a flashlight for returning to your vehicle after the event, portable chairs and a light jacket since it can get breezy near the water after dark.
